PSED

In class will be sharing stories about different emotions and feelings and teaching strategies to help the children manage their emotions. We will be encouraging the children to take pride in their efforts and achievements and working on improving self-esteem and confidence.

The children will be working collaboratively on projects and will be supported in learning how to make supportive recommendations to a friend about how they may make an improvement to their work.

Physical Development

PE lessons this term will continue to focus on developing the children's gross motor skills. The children will be learning how to move their bodies in different ways, to balance and to safely climb apparatus. They will be improving their memories and performance skills by learning new skipping and hopping games.

UTW

This term the children will be learning about space and exploring spaceships using the role play area.

The children will be challenged to design and build, and create their own mini spaceships.

We will be looking at different scientific concepts such as changes in state (melting, freezing and floating). We will also introduce the children to simple electrical circuits.

In Forest School the children will be experiencing the features of winter and what our environment is like at this time of year.

We will also be planting Spring bulbs.

Extraordinary explorers and experimenters! Term 3

Mathematics

We will be continuing our Maths Mastery by exploring zero and numbers 1, 2 and 3 in depth..

The children will be continuing to learn their numbers to 5 and comparing numbers of objects.

The children will be comparing capacity, mass and learning new vocabulary relating to measure.



Communication & Language

This term the children will be encouraged to speak using 3-4 word sentences. We will be providing opportunities for them to hold conversations with another child about a subject of interest to them. We will continue to encourage answers in full sentences about how they are feeling. With the older children, we would like them to say why they are feeling that way using the word 'because'.

We will be regularly practising the skills children need to talk about a story they have read or listened to and to ask and answer questions in response to what is read.

The children will be exploring non-fiction texts and learning that they are sources of information and we will challenge them to learn facts and new words from these books.

To learn a poem or rhyme to recite

EAD

This term the children will be learning how to mix colors to make new colors, experimenting with lighter and darker shades.

They will be copying musical tunes and rhythms.

Literacy:

The children will continue learning new nursery rhymes and songs this term. We will continue to practice our phonics by focusing on sounds in the environment and recognizing words with the same initial sound. We will continue to recognize our names, signs in the local environment and also practice writing our names.
