

Welcome to Term 6! We hope you have all had a wonderful half term break.



Clothing

As always, we remind all parents that children need to come to Nursery in suitable play clothes. You can purchase a Nursery polo shirt from Superstich. Due to the messy nature of Nursery we ask that all children come in with a spare set of clothes in their bag. As we are outside every day and have regular Forest School sessions we also ask that you provide a pair of wellies to help keep their feet dry. These can come in each session or can be kept in nursery for your convenience.

Coming to nursery your child will need:

- Comfortable play clothes with easy fastenings to promote independence.
- A waterproof coat for those Spring showers
- Wellies to splash in the puddles!
- A healthy packed lunch or a pre-ordered hot lunch (order via Parentpay)
- A spare set of clean clothes including underwear and socks
- Nappies and wipes (if needed)
- Lots of additional clothes if we are supporting with potty/toilet training.

In addition to this we ask that you return the loaned resources promptly to ensure that other families can borrow them too.
