Every child who has managed to read 10-12 books by the end of the year, will take part in the celebration reading event.








What books are we studying in Autumn Term 2?


Each phase has set text(s) for reading and writing that develop core objectives and key skills. This is what each year group will be studying during Autumn 2.

Year 5 and 6: Dolphins, Marlin and Sharks.


