East Sussex Fire and Rescue, Sussex Police, Ambulance Service, Southern Rail and others are all working together to teach children about safety and crime prevention.

Participation in this event will support the children in providing high quality PSHE education with the different risk scenarios, supporting concepts and skills identified within the PHSE Association's Programme of Study.

Each child taking part will receive a participation certificate and information relating to safety issues.
