Step 4: Using Suffixes

National Curriculum Objectives:

English Year 4: Spell words with endings sounding like /zə/ or /tʃə/, /zən/ and /ʃən/ spelt –tion, –sion, –ssion, –cian

English Year 4: Spell using the suffixes –ation, –ous and –ly

English Year 4: Add suffixes beginning with vowel letters to words of more than one syllable

English Year 4: Use further prefixes and suffixes and understand how to add them - see English appendix

Differentiation:

Developing Questions to support writing and using the suffixes ‘-sure’, ‘-ture’, ‘-cher’, ‘-tion’ and ‘-cian’.

Expected Questions to support writing and using the suffixes ‘-sure’, ‘-ture’, ‘-cher’, ‘-tion’ and ‘-cian’, in addition to ‘-ly’ and ‘-ous’.

Greater Depth Questions to support writing and using the suffixes ‘-sure’, ‘-ture’, ‘-cher’, ‘-tion’ and ‘-cian’, in addition to ‘-ly’ and ‘-ous’. This includes words which are exceptions to the usual spelling rules or where a prefix has also been added.
